After completing karting drive training from 1994 to 1999, and a brief stint in SAXO CUP and VENTURI 400 TROPHIES, Morgan Moullin-Traffort, Discovered by Michel Nourry began his career in FFSA GT in 2002. By moving through the championships along with pilots such as Jean-Philippe Belloc, James Ruffier and Anthony Beltoise, year after year, he successfully progressed to the top four of French and European championships. France's Junior Champion in 2005, he joined the « Sofrev ASP » team in 2006. With this team, he built and affirmed his place among professional pilots. He won his third championship position in the MATMUT PORSCHE CARRERA CUP in 2008 after a highly contested race. Today, Morgan Moullin-Traffort strives for International recognition to complete his already remarkable career his career already promising.
